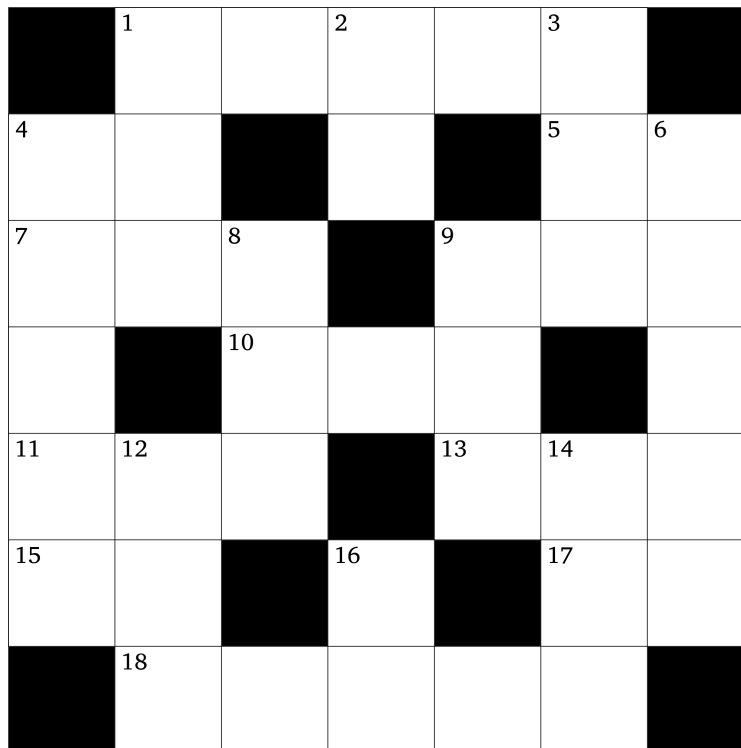


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #11

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Forty-four times a prime number
- 9 across minus 9 down
- All digits are the same
- Eight times a prime number
- 1 across divided by 5 across
- Mean of 8 down and 4 across
- A prime number
- Nine times a prime number
- Same as 2 down
- Two-thirds of 4 across
- Seven times a square

Down

- Seven times 5 across
- A prime number
- All digits are the same
- 17 across plus half of 6 down
- Ninety times a prime number
- Seven times a prime number
- 18 across divided by 16 down
- Thirteen times a prime number
- Half of 7 across, then subtract 15 across
- A prime number
