- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

- Eleven times 3 down
- A prime number
- Six times a prime number
- Mean of 8 across and 7 across
- Two-fifths of 11 down
- Twice the result of 9 across minus 7 across
- A prime number
- 5 down divided by 6 across
- 3 across plus half of 1 across
- 4 across minus 10 down

### Down

- 3 down reversed
- 2 down reversed
- Fifty-two times a prime number
- A square
- Five times a prime number
