
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #14

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Twenty-eight times a prime number
- **3** Half of 11 across, then subtract 10 down
- 4 Mean of 1 across and 3 down
- **6** 9 across minus 12 across
- 7 Mean of 11 across and 3 down
- 9 Nine times a prime number
- 11 6 across plus 5 down
- **12** Twice a prime number

Down

- **2** 11 across divided by eleven
- **3** Two-thirds of 10 down
- **5** 7 across minus 8 down
- 8 Four times 3 down
- **9** Four times a prime number
- 10 Twice a square
