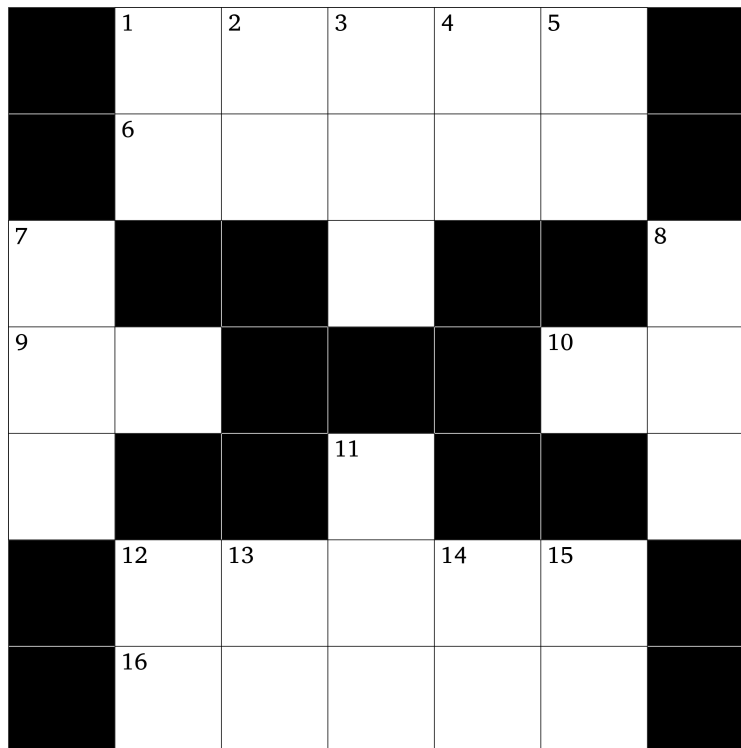


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #31

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Nine thousand four more than 16 across
- 6 Ten times a prime number
- 9 Mean of 14 down and 15 down
- 10 12 down plus 13 down
- 12 Twenty-eight times a prime number
- 16 Four times a prime number

Down

- 1 A prime number
- 2 A prime number
- 3 Twice 1 down
- 4 Half of 8 down, then subtract 3 down
- 5 Sum of digits in 1 across
- 7 A square
- 8 Twice a prime number
- 11 2 down plus half of 7 down
- 12 7 down divided by fifty-six
- 13 9 across minus 1 down
- 14 Twice a prime number
- 15 Mean of 2 down and 4 down
