
## Difficulty:

# CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #49

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

#### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### Across

- **3** 14 across minus half of 5 across
- **5** Twice a prime number
- **6** Twice a prime number
- **7** Fifty-five times a square
- **8** Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 9 8 across plus 1 down
- **11** Six times a prime number
- **13** Same as 14 across

#### 14 Twelve times a prime number

#### Down

- **1** All digits are the same
- **2** A palindrome
- 4 Ten thousand one hundred forty-six less than 5 down
- **5** First two digits are the same as first two digits of 7 across
- **10** 4 down divided by 6 across
- 12 Half of 7 across, then subtract 11 across
