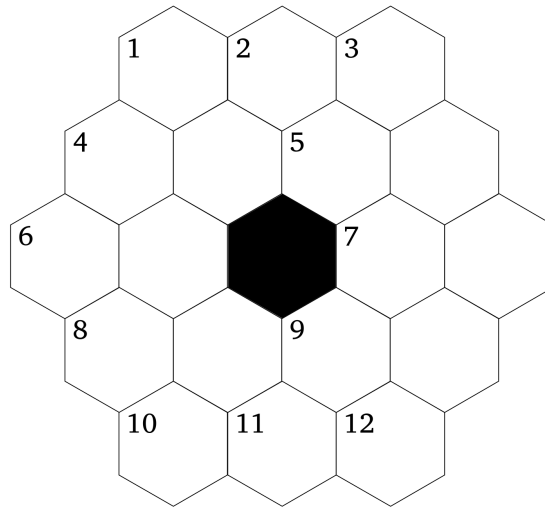
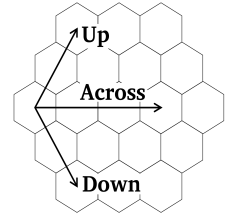


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #16

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 A prime number
- 4 Mean of 2 down and 1 down
- 6 Six times a square
- 7 Twice a prime number
- 8 3 down plus 1 across
- 10 Fifteen times a prime number

Up

- 5 A square
- 6 10 across minus 6 across
- 8 Seven times a prime number
- 10 6 up divided by eleven
- 11 Seven times a prime number
- 12 A cube

Down

- 1 10 across divided by fifteen
- 2 A prime number
- 3 Thirty-two times a prime number
- 4 Five times a prime number
- 6 Four times a prime number
- 9 Three times a square
