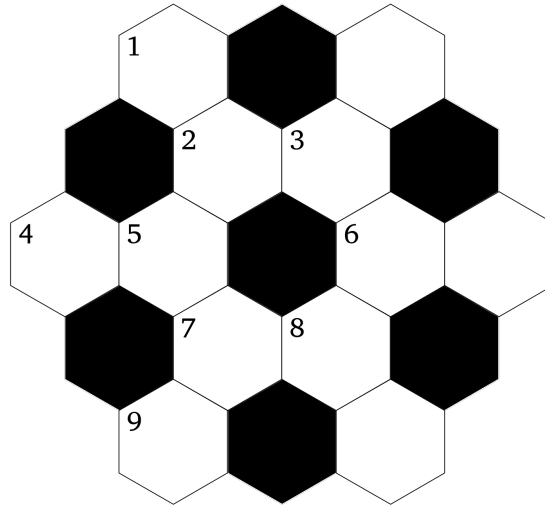
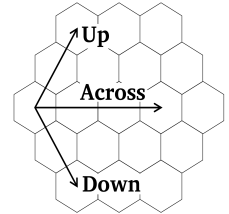


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #64

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 9 up plus 3 down
- 4 2 across reversed
- 6 Twice the result of 9 up plus 4 across
- 7 5 down reversed

Up

- 3 2 across minus 1 down
- 5 Mean of 5 down and 8 down
- 8 Four more than 2 across
- 9 A square

Down

- 1 Same as 4 across
- 3 5 up minus 3 up
- 5 A square
- 8 7 across minus 5 up
