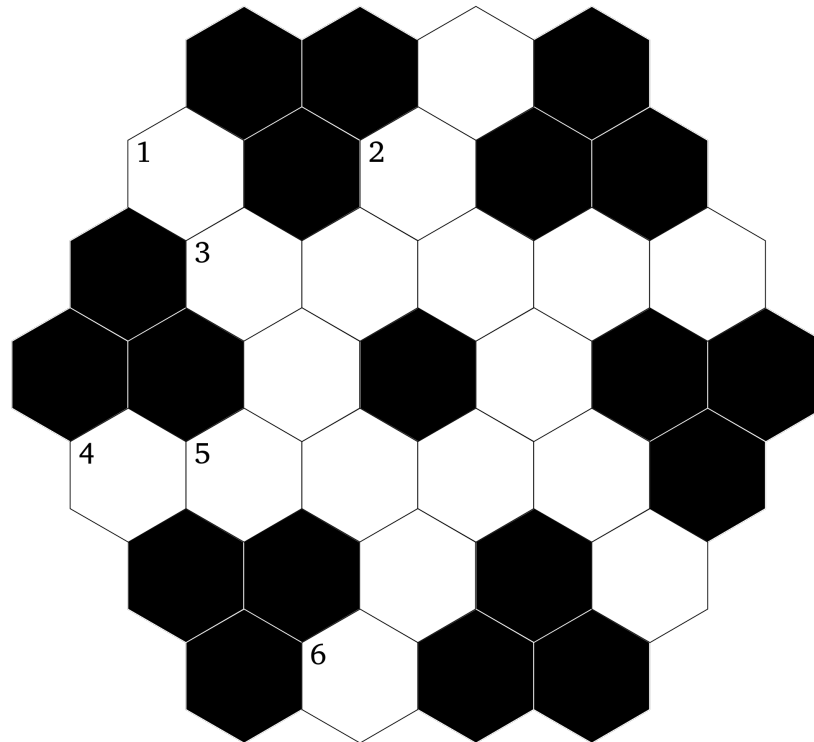
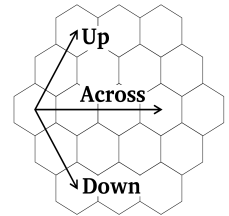


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #80

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 3 2 down plus 4 across
 4 Four thousand one hundred thirty-seven less than 6 up

Up

- 5 6 up plus half of 1 down
 6 Four times a prime number

Down

- 1 Seventy-six times a prime number
 2 Sixteen thousand three hundred twenty-nine more than 1 down
