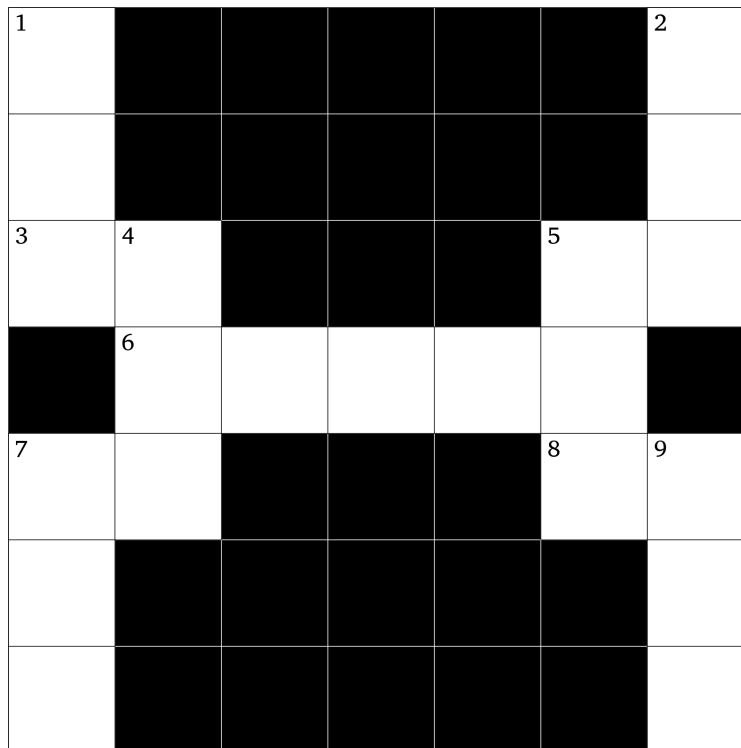


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #35

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 3 9 down divided by four
- 5 9 down minus 8 across
- 6 7 down times 5 down
- 7 Three times a prime number
- 8 A prime number

Down

- 1 4 down minus 2 down
- 2 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 4 Forty-five times 7 across
- 5 Nineteen times a prime number
- 7 A square
- 9 Four more than 7 down
