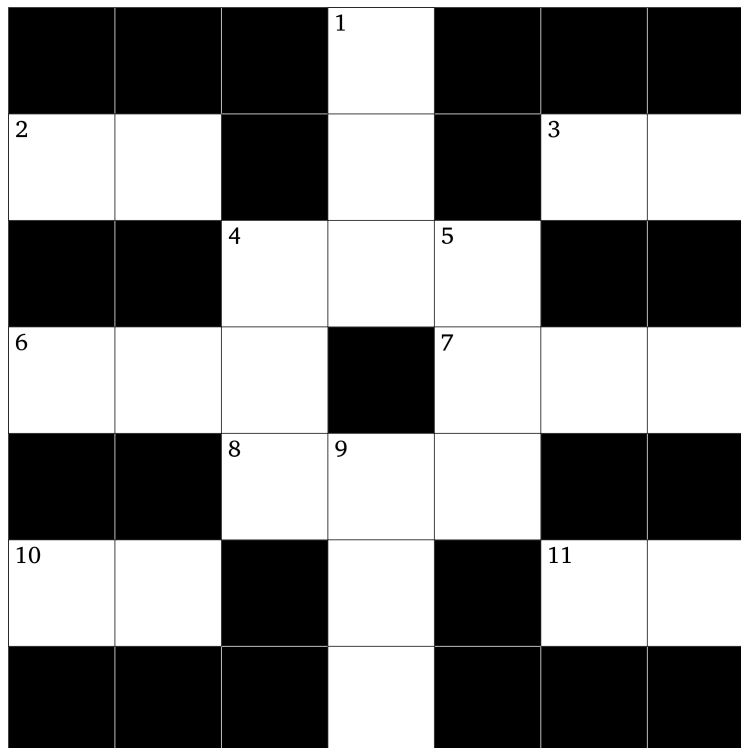


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #36

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 8 across minus 4 down
- Five times a prime number
- Mean of 5 down and 2 across
- Forty-two times a square
- Eighty-nine times 10 across
- Half of 7 across, then subtract 1 down
- Twice the result of 9 down minus 4 across

Down

- 4 across divided by five
- Sixty-seven less than 4 across
- Fifty-three times 10 across
- Fourteen times a prime number
