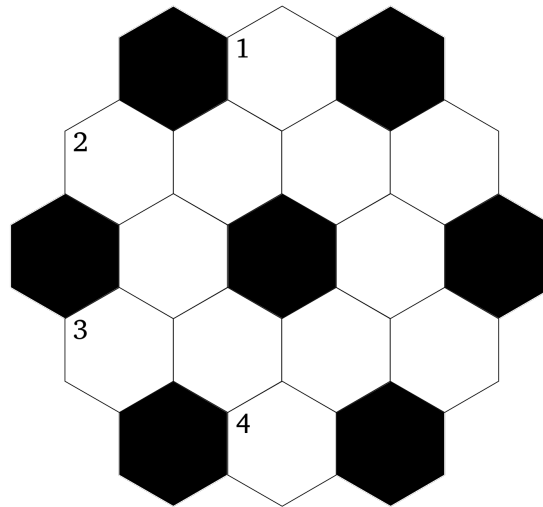
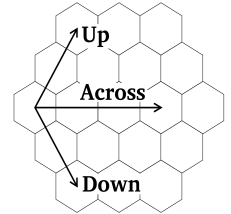


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #24

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 A square
3 Half of 4 up, then subtract 3 up

Up

- 3 A prime number
4 Eighty-eight times a prime number

Down

- 1 Two hundred seventy-four less than 2 down
2 Two thousand two hundred twenty-five less than 4 up
