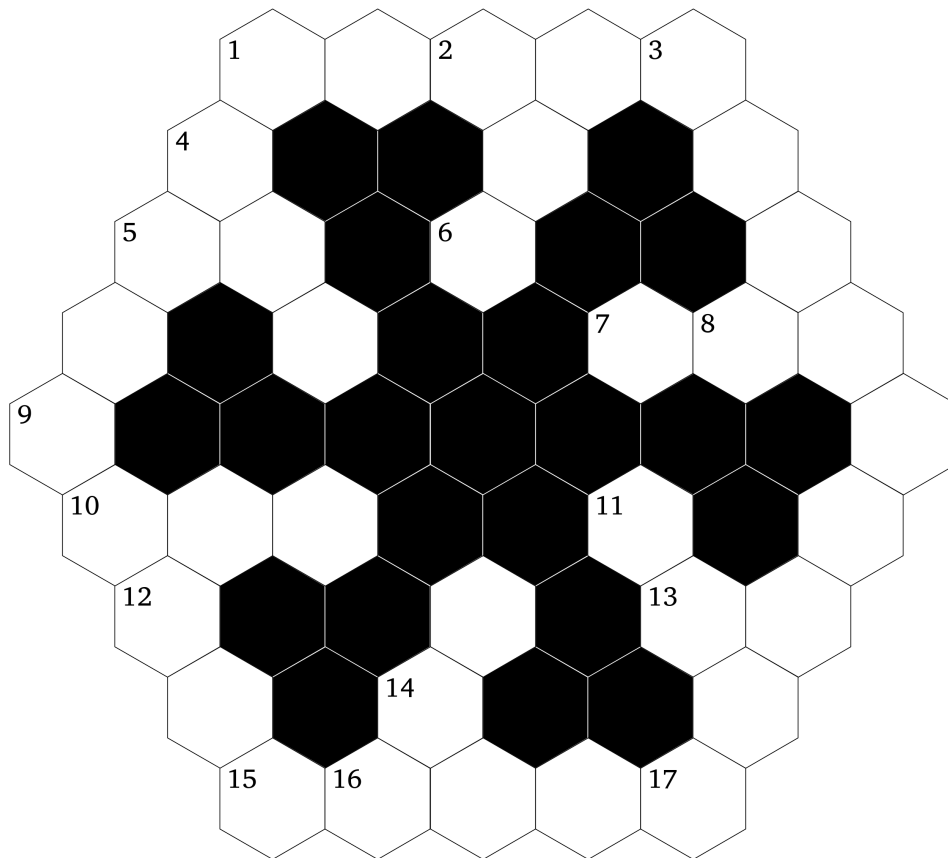
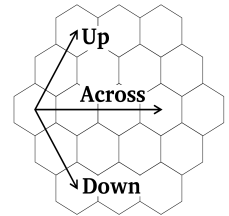


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #86

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 5 Three-fifths of 14 down
 7 Fifteen times a prime number
 10 4 down minus 12 up
 13 7 across divided by 8 up
 15 Two thousand two hundred twenty-eight more than 9 up

Up

- 6 3 down divided by 11 down
 8 2 down reversed
 9 Fourteen times a prime number
 12 Twice a prime number
 16 9 down minus 15 across
 17 Four times a prime number

Down

- 2 8 up reversed
 3 Fifty-nine times a square
 4 Nineteen times a prime number
 9 A palindrome
 11 Twice a square
 14 9 up minus half of 1 across
