
## Difficulty:

# CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #6

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### Across

**1** Three times a prime number **12** 1 across plus half of 2 down

#### Down

- **2** Consecutive digits in descending order
- **3** Mean of 5 down and 6 down
- 4 5 down reversed
- 5 Mean of 12 across and 9 down
- 6 Twice 11 down
- **7** Three-fourths of 2 down
- 8 Three-fourths of 10 down
- ${\bf 9}\,$  Mean of 4 down and 10 down
- 10 5 down plus 4 down
- 11 8 down minus 7 down
