


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #8

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **7** Three-fourths of 6 down
- 8 Fifteen more than 10 down
- **9** 5 down times 7 across

Down

- 1 3 down divided by 10 down
- 2 Mean of 4 across and 8 across
- 3 Rearranged digits of 9 across
- **5** Five times a square
- **6** Fourteen times a square
- 10 Consecutive digits in ascending order
