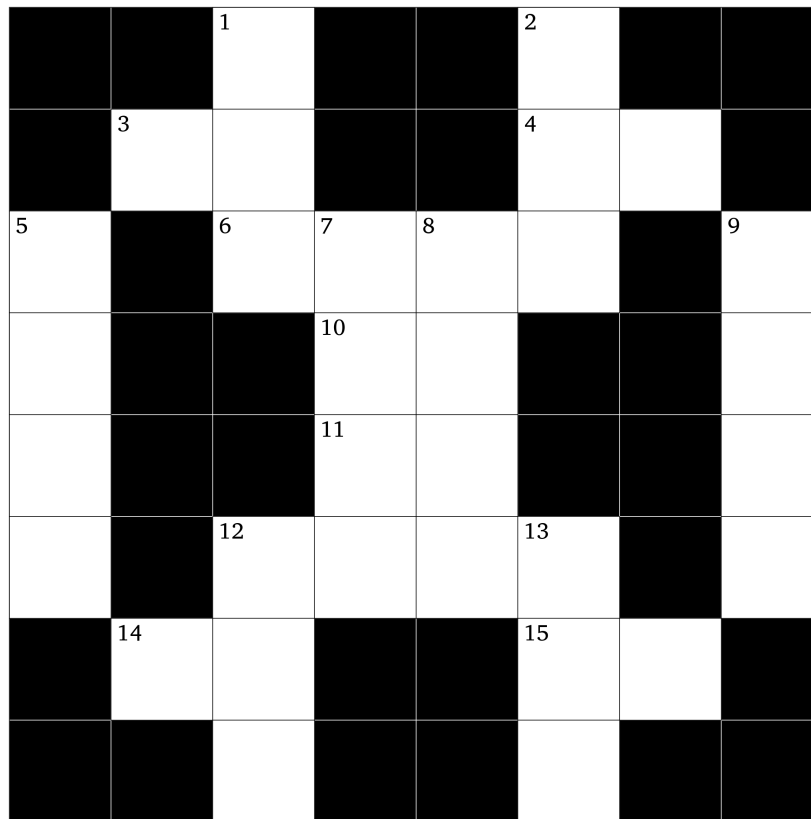


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #12

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- All digits are the same
- Three-fifths of 3 across
- Three hundred fifty-two less than 12 across
- Three times 4 across
- Five times a square
- Mean of 7 down and 12 down
- A prime number
- 9 down divided by 14 across

Down

- Twenty-three times 14 across
- Mean of 1 down and 13 down
- Twice a prime number
- Fifteen times a prime number
- Half of 5 down, then subtract 6 across
- One hundred fifty-three less than 6 across
- 8 down divided by seventeen
- A prime number
