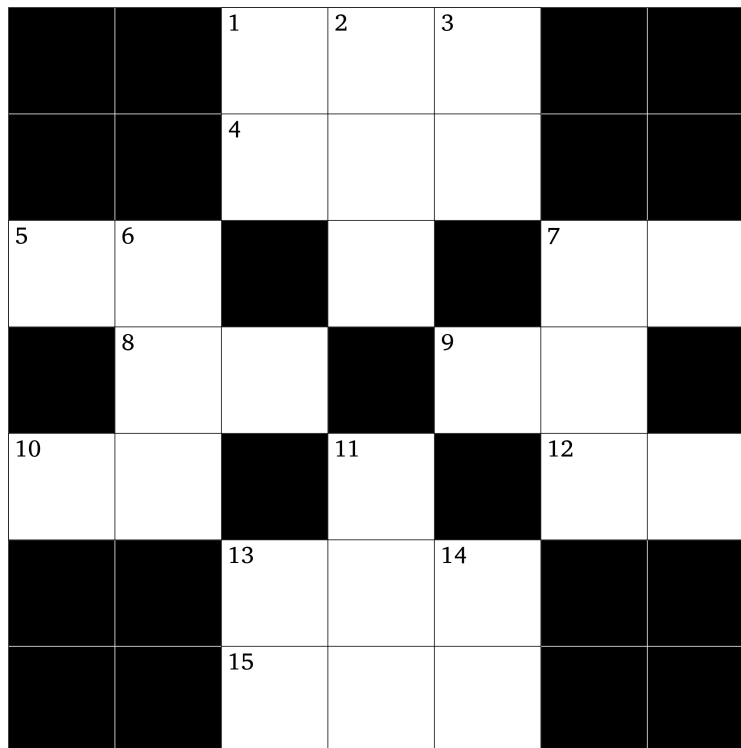


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle # 16

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 11 down minus 10 across
- Twenty-seven times 8 across
- 9 across minus 7 across
- 5 across reversed
- Two-fifths of 7 across
- 4 across minus 13 across
- A prime number
- Mean of 8 across and 14 down
- 6 down minus 12 across
- Fourteen times a prime number

Down

- 5 across minus 8 across
- 8 across times 10 across
- Six times 8 across
- 15 across minus half of 1 down
- 12 across plus half of 1 across
- A prime number
- 3 down divided by five
- Mean of 5 across and 12 across
