
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #17

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** 2 down plus 13 down
- **3** Twice the result of 12 across minus 7 across
- **5** Seventeen times a square
- 7 Same as 10 across
- 8 Mean of 2 down and 3 down
- 9 Half of 5 across, then subtract 11 across
- **10** 6 down minus half of 4 down
- **11** Four-fifths of 13 down
- 12 Seven times 2 down
- **14** Mean of 15 across and 1 across
- 15 1 across plus 2 down

Down

- **2** A square
- **3** 13 down plus 15 across
- 4 Four times a prime number
- **12** 15 across divided by three
- 13 A square
