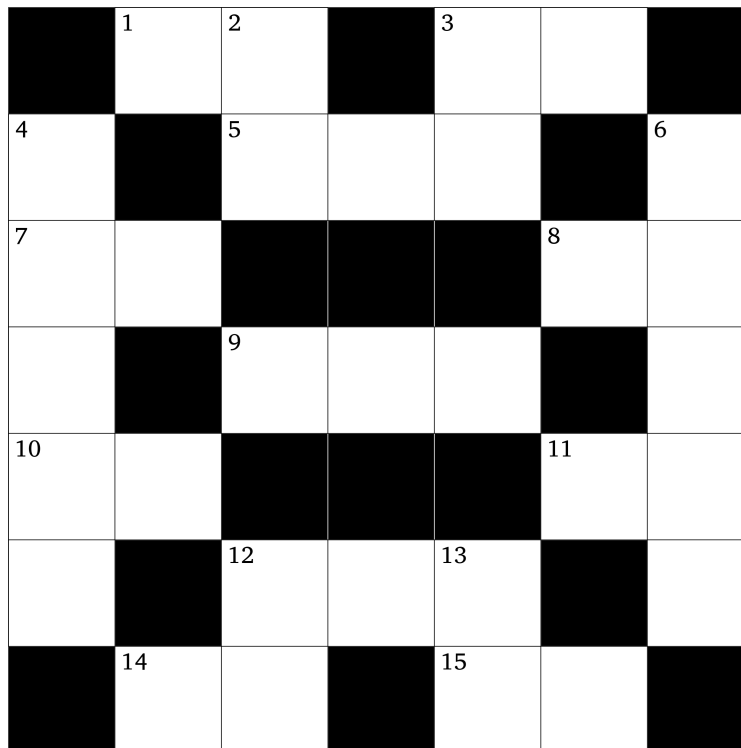


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #17

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 down plus 13 down
- Twice the result of 12 across minus 7 across
- Seventeen times a square
- Same as 10 across
- Mean of 2 down and 3 down
- Half of 5 across, then subtract 11 across
- 6 down minus half of 4 down
- Four-fifths of 13 down
- Seven times 2 down
- Mean of 15 across and 1 across
- 1 across plus 2 down

Down

- A square
- 13 down plus 15 across
- Four times a prime number
- 15 across divided by three
- A square
