- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

- One thousand sixty-six more than 1 across
- Twice a prime number
- Sum of digits in 12 down
- Twenty-five less than 7 down
- Mean of 15 down and 3 down
- Twice the result of 9 down minus 10 across
- Forty-four times a prime number
- Twice the result of 6 across plus 17 down

Down

- Fourteen times a square
- A prime number
- Ten times a square
- Seven times a square
- Nine times 11 across
- Sixteen times a prime number
- Twenty-six times a prime number
- Five times a prime number
- Twice the result of 1 down minus 7 across
- Three times a square
- 13 across plus 11 across
- Mean of 7 across and 13 across
