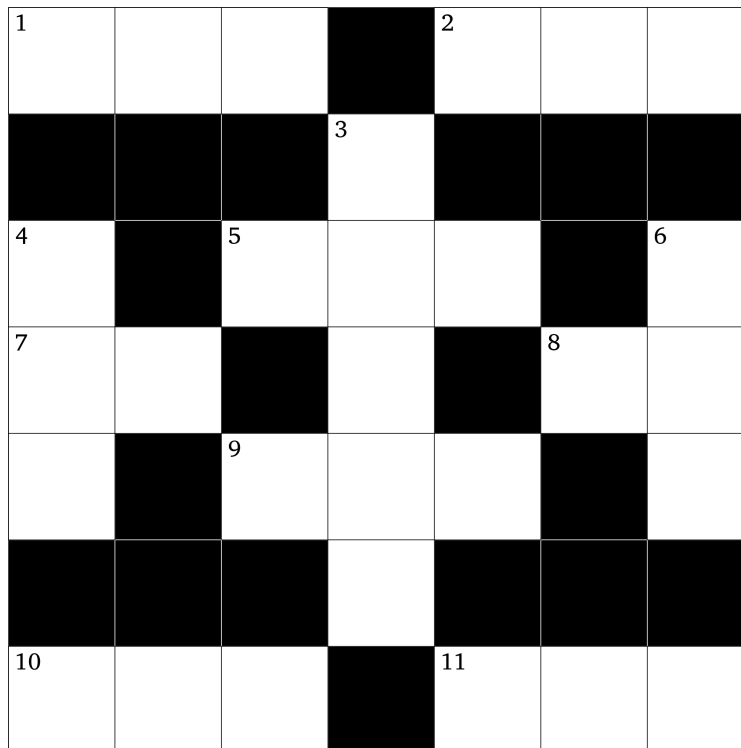


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #23

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 9 across plus 11 across
- Mean of 1 across and 10 across
- Eleven times a square
- Consecutive digits in descending order
- Twice the result of 10 across minus 7 across
- Twice a square
- A cube
- Three times 10 across

Down

- First two digits are the same as 7 across
- 3 down divided by 2 across
- Three-fifths of 5 across
