
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #27

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Same as 13 across
- **5** 10 across plus 14 down
- 7 Mean of 8 down and 3 down
- **9** Twice a prime number
- 10 Mean of 5 across and 12 down **11** 4 down minus 6 down
- 13 9 down plus half of 9 across
- 16 Twenty-six times 1 down

Down

- 1 Sum of digits in 1 across
- **2** Mean of 14 down and 9 across
- **3** 7 across minus 1 down
- 4 11 across plus 9 across
- **6** 14 down minus 9 across
- 8 10 down plus 2 down
- **9** A square
- **10** A square
- 12 Twice the result of 13 down plus 11 across
- **13** 2 down reversed
- **14** 10 across minus 12 down
- **15** Twice the result of 6 down plus 4 down
