


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #30

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **2** Fifty-five times a square
- **4** Consecutive digits in ascending order
- **6** Consecutive digits in descending order
- **7** Twice the result of 9 down plus 9 across
- **9** A square
- **10** 11 down times 12 across
- 11 6 down divided by 3 down
- 12 Mean of 8 down and 11 across
- **14** Ten more than 15 across
- 15 13 down minus 16 across
- 16 Half of 2 across, then subtract 4 across

Down

- 1 Forty-one less than 8 down
- **3** Two hundred fifteen less than 2 across
- **5** Thirty-two times a prime number
- **8** Twenty-seven times a prime number
- **9** All digits are the same
- 11 Seven times a prime number
- **13** 1 down plus 14 across
