


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #33

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Ten times a prime number
- 2 Twice 3 down
- 4 17 across plus 11 down
- **5** 10 down minus 2 across
- 7 10 down minus 2 across
- **9** Half of 1 across, then subtract 15 across
- **13** Eighty-six times 2 across
- **14** Ten more than 12 down
- 15 Mean of 14 across and 4 across
- 17 18 across minus 16 down
- **18** 13 across divided by eighty-six
- **19** Ninety-two times 17 across

Down

- **3** 5 across plus half of 7 across
- **4** A square
- 6 Fifteen times a square
- **7** Sixteen times a prime number
- 8 Half of 4 down, then subtract 17 across
- **10** 2 across plus 8 down
- **11** 6 down divided by 12 down
- 12 4 down plus 3 down
- 14 2 across plus 10 down
- 16 19 across divided by 4 across
