


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #34

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Three thousand four hundred thirty-nine more than 14
- 3 13 across plus 12 down
- **4** A square
- **6** Twenty-five times a prime number
- **9** Seven times a prime number
- **10** Six times a prime number
- **11** A prime number
- 13 4 across minus 2 down
- 14 Twice the result of 5 down plus 3 across

Down

- 1 1 across divided by 6 across
- **2** 13 across plus 1 down
- **5** Nine times a prime number
- **6** Twice a prime number
- **7** 3 down divided by 10 across
- **8** 13 across times 13 down
- 12 9 across minus 11 across
- 13 Twice a prime number
