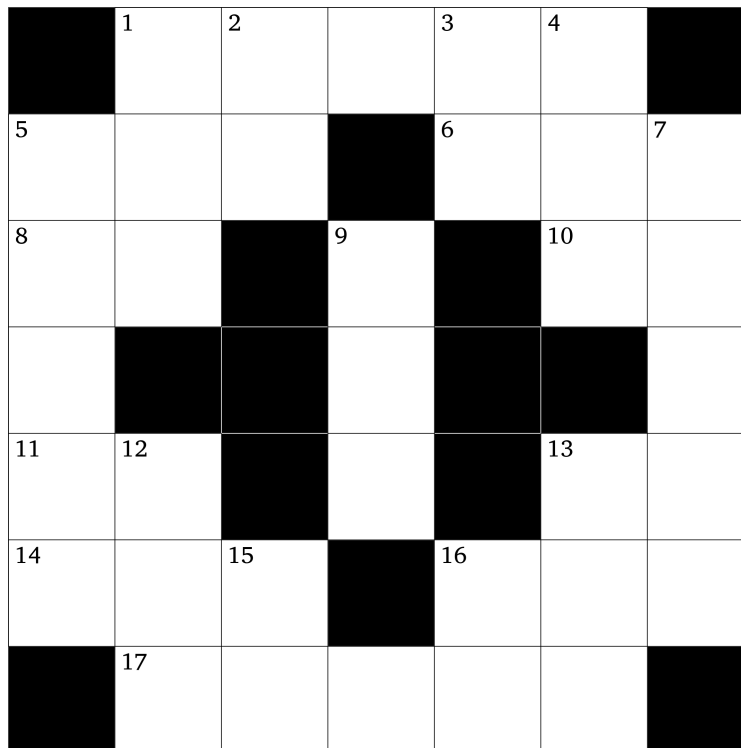


## CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #39

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 1 14 across times 8 across
- 5 Twenty-eight times a prime number
- 6 4 down reversed
- 8 Four times a prime number
- 10 2 down divided by six
- 11 9 down minus half of 13 across
- 13 Ten times a square
- 14 Four times a prime number
- 16 Twenty times a prime number
- 17 12 down times 6 across

### Down

- 1 16 down plus 12 down
- 2 5 across minus 16 across
- 3 Three-fourths of 8 across
- 4 6 across reversed
- 5 Six thousand seven hundred forty-two more than 17 across
- 7 Its digits total 10 across
- 9 Twice a square
- 12 Twice a prime number
- 13 Four times a prime number
- 15 A prime number
- 16 Half of 13 down, then subtract 1 down
