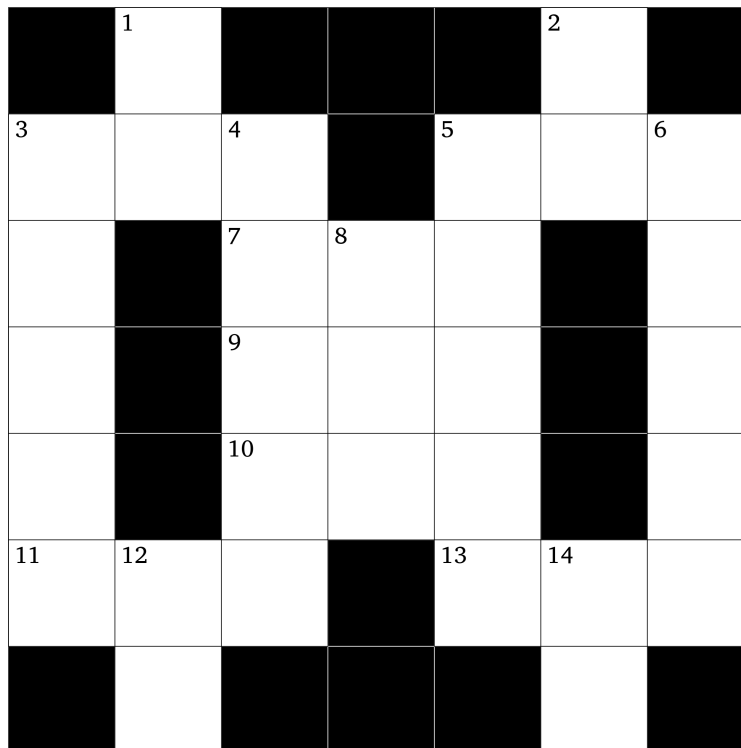


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #42

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 3 11 across minus 14 down
- 5 Three times a prime number
- 7 Seven times 12 down
- 9 Sixteen times a prime number
- 10 6 down divided by 12 down
- 11 Fifty-five times a square
- 13 Half of 9 across, then subtract 2 down

Down

- 1 8 down minus 7 across
- 2 Six times a prime number
- 3 5 down plus 5 across
- 4 Nine thousand two hundred ninety-two less than 6 down
- 5 A prime number
- 6 Thirteen thousand five hundred forty-six less than 3 down
- 8 Fourteen times a prime number
- 12 A square
- 14 Four-fifths of 2 down
