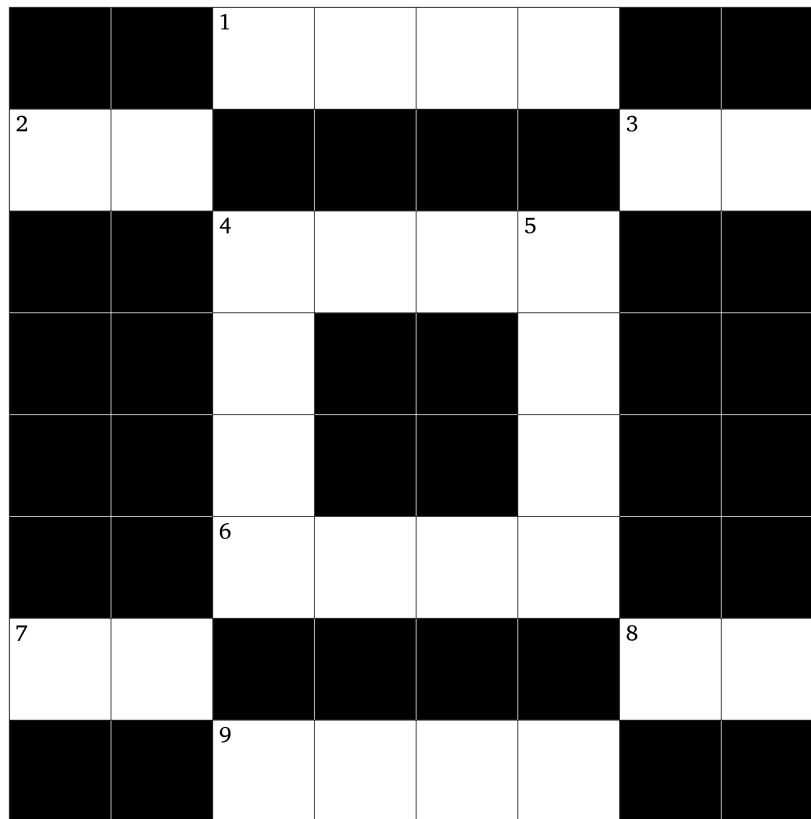


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #44

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Seventeen times a square
- 8 across minus 7 across
- 1 across divided by 8 across
- Twenty-seven times a prime number
- A square
- 4 across minus 5 down
- Consecutive digits in ascending order
- Three hundred thirteen less than 5 down

Down

- 9 across plus half of 2 across
- Two-fifths of 6 across
