
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #44

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

- **1** Seventeen times a square
- **2** 8 across minus 7 across
- **3** 1 across divided by 8 across
- 4 Twenty-seven times a prime number
- **6** A square
- **7** 4 across minus 5 down
- **8** Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 9 Three hundred thirteen less than 5 down
