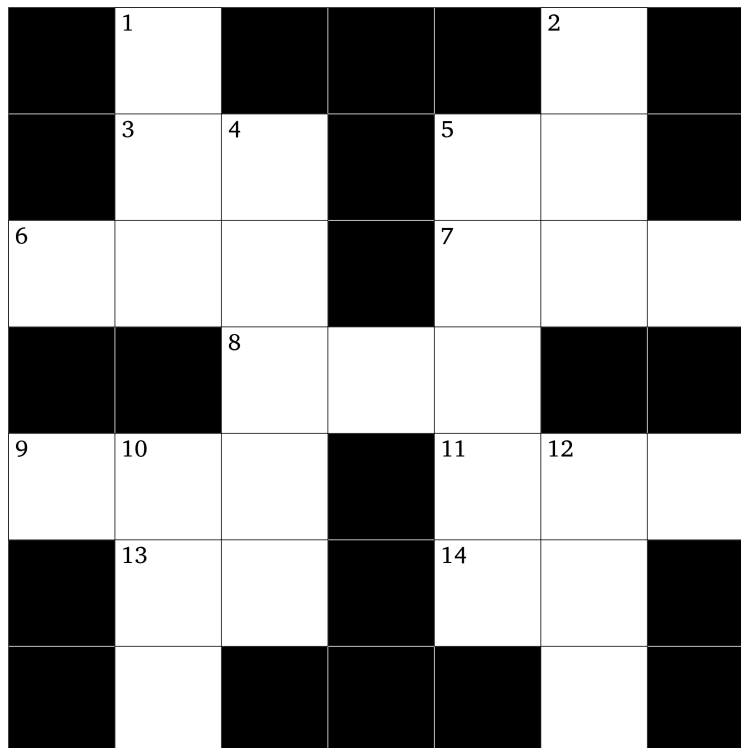


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #49

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 3 14 across minus half of 5 across
- 5 Twice a prime number
- 6 Twice a prime number
- 7 Fifty-five times a square
- 8 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 9 8 across plus 1 down
- 11 Six times a prime number
- 13 Same as 14 across
- 14 Twelve times a prime number

Down

- 1 All digits are the same
- 2 A palindrome
- 4 Ten thousand one hundred forty-six less than 5 down
- 5 First two digits are the same as first two digits of 7 across
- 10 4 down divided by 6 across
- 12 Half of 7 across, then subtract 11 across
