
TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #3

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across


- **2** Seventy times a square
- 4 Seven times a prime number
- **5** Thirty-nine times a prime number

Up

- **5** Twice the result of 1 down plus 4 across
- 6 Twice a prime number
- 7 Twice the result of 2 across plus 2 down

Down

- **1** Forty-three times a prime number
- **2** Five times a prime number
- **3** Consecutive digits unordered
