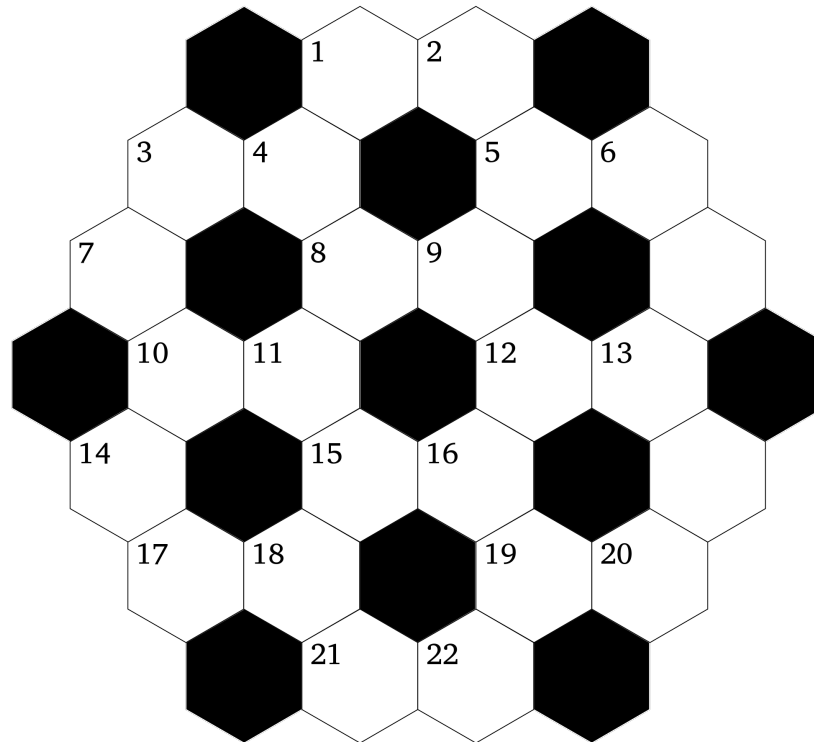
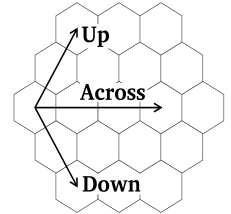


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #8

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 A square
- 3 A square
- 5 A square
- 8 Four times 19 across
- 10 9 down plus 16 down
- 12 Half of 20 up, then subtract 13 up
- 15 Mean of 9 up and 17 across
- 17 Mean of 22 up and 18 down
- 19 20 up minus 15 across
- 21 6 down divided by four

Up

- 4 Same as 8 across
- 7 17 across minus 13 up
- 9 A square
- 11 A square
- 13 Mean of 16 up and 14 down
- 14 21 across plus half of 14 down
- 16 10 across minus 9 up
- 18 Half of 4 down, then subtract 19 across
- 20 21 across plus 15 across
- 22 9 down minus 2 down

Down

- 2 Half of 6 down, then subtract 7 up
- 4 20 up minus 16 up
- 6 Same as 8 across
- 7 18 down plus 13 down
- 9 10 across minus 18 down
- 11 A square
- 13 Same as 13 up
- 14 17 across minus 21 across
- 16 4 down divided by six
- 18 7 up minus 16 up
