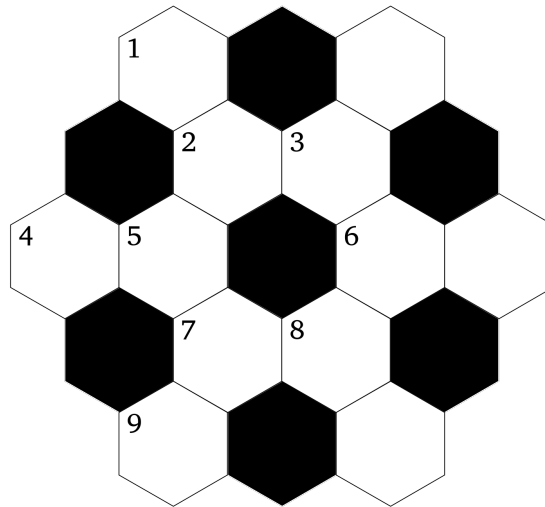
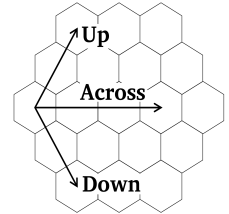


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #11

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Mean of 9 up and 3 up
- 4 8 down plus 5 up
- 6 7 across plus half of 5 down
- 7 A prime number

Up

- 3 Half of 1 down, then subtract 3 down
- 5 Same as 5 down
- 8 A prime number
- 9 A square

Down

- 1 5 down plus 3 up
- 3 A cube
- 5 4 across minus 8 down
- 8 6 across divided by six
