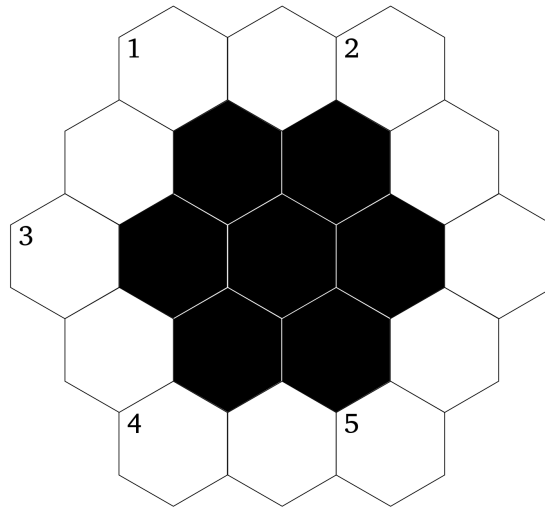
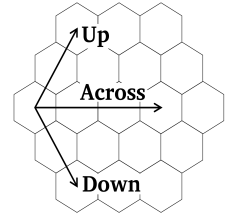


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #15

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 4 across minus 5 up
- 4 Five more than 2 down

Up

- 3 Seven times a prime number
- 5 Mean of 1 across and 3 up

Down

- 2 Mean of 3 up and 3 down
- 3 Twenty-three times a square
