
TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #16

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** A prime number
- 4 Mean of 2 down and 1 down
- **6** Six times a square
- **7** Twice a prime number
- 8 3 down plus 1 across


10 Fifteen times a prime number

Up

- **5** A square
- **6** 10 across minus 6 across
- **8** Seven times a prime number
- **10** 6 up divided by eleven
- **11** Seven times a prime number
- 12 A cube

Down

- 1 10 across divided by fifteen
- **2** A prime number
- **3** Thirty-two times a prime number
- **4** Five times a prime number
- **6** Four times a prime number
- **9** Three times a square
