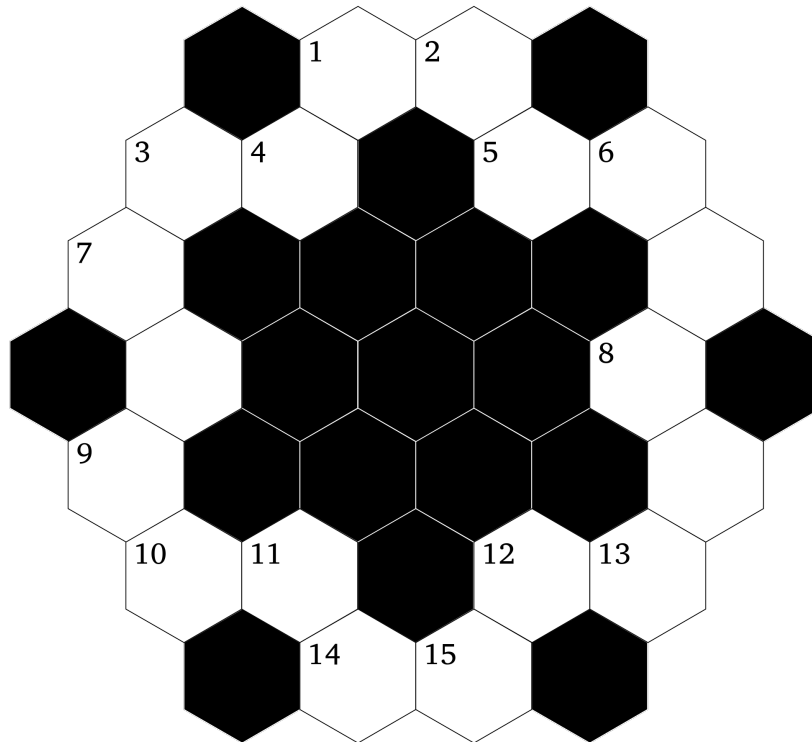


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #17

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 A square
- 3 11 down minus 9 down
- 5 Same as 11 down
- 10 Twice the result of 7 down minus 9 down
- 12 5 across minus 13 up
- 14 11 down plus half of 8 up

Up

- 4 10 across minus 15 up
- 7 Three times a prime number
- 8 7 down divided by eight
- 9 Mean of 2 down and 1 across
- 13 14 across minus 3 across
- 15 4 up plus 12 across

Down

- 2 Mean of 1 across and 3 across
- 6 Mean of 11 down and 14 across
- 7 Twice 2 down
- 8 15 up divided by four
- 9 5 across minus 3 across
- 11 12 across plus 13 up
