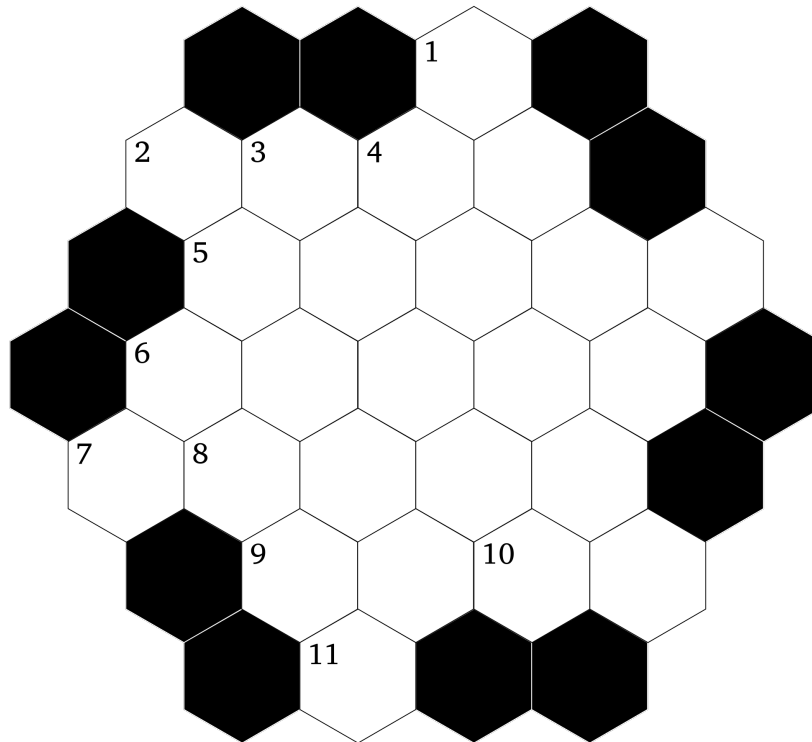
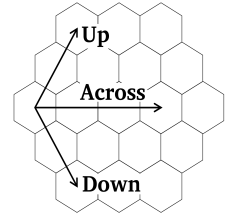


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #30

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Twenty-eight times a prime number
 5 Half of 8 up, then subtract 6 across
 6 Ten times a prime number
 7 A prime number
 9 One hundred sixty-two more than 2 across

Up

- 7 Fifty-two times a prime number
 8 Fourteen times a prime number
 9 Three thousand eight hundred seventy-eight less than 8 up
 10 Seven times a square
 11 Half of 4 down, then subtract 2 across

Down

- 1 Thirty times a prime number
 2 One thousand three hundred thirty-six more than 9 up
 3 A prime number
 4 First two digits are the same as first two digits of 1 down
 6 2 down divided by forty-seven
