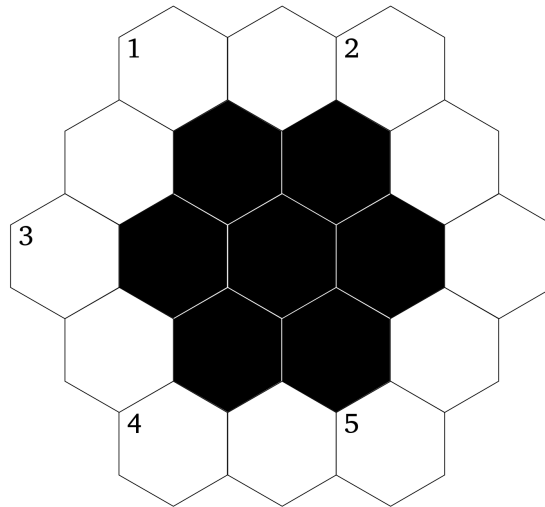
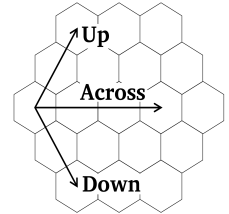


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #37

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Six times a prime number
- 4 Twice the result of 2 down minus 3 up

Up

- 3 Twenty-four more than 3 down
- 5 Two-thirds of 3 down

Down

- 2 Ten times a square
- 3 Consecutive digits in ascending order

Solution:
