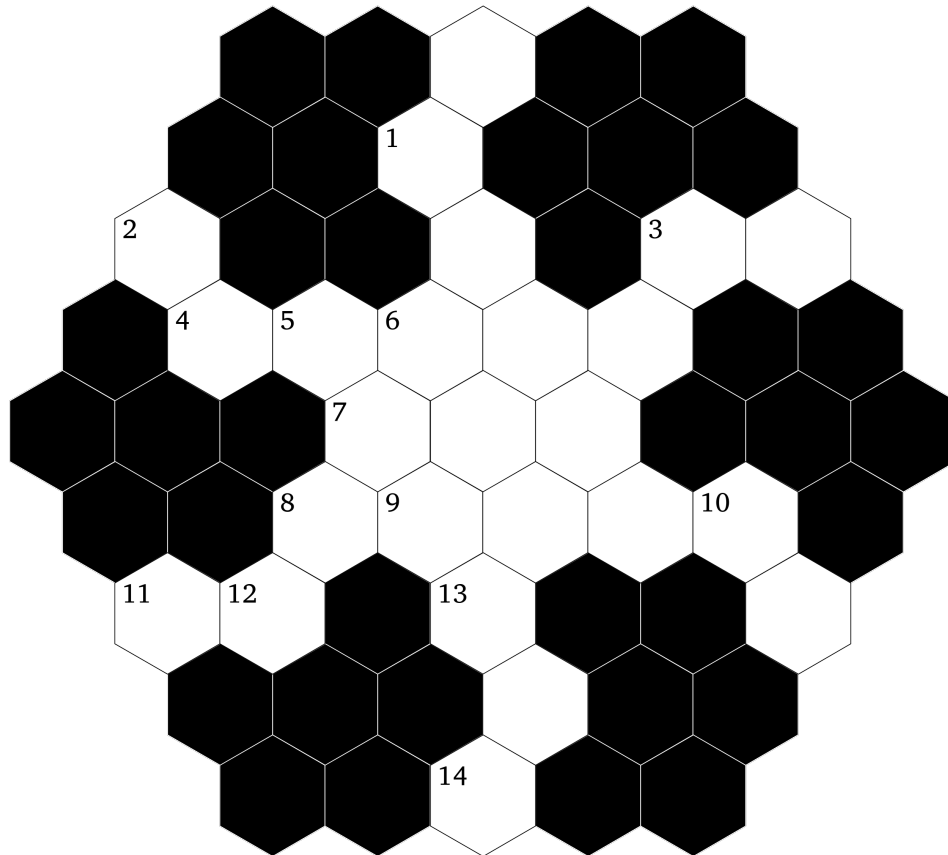
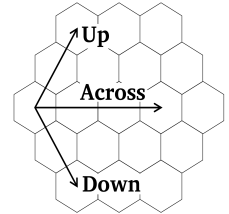


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #52

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 3 14 up minus 2 down
- 4 Sixteen times a prime number
- 7 1 down divided by 6 down
- 8 Forty-two times a prime number
- 11 Half of 10 down

Up

- 1 A square
- 9 Four times 11 across
- 12 A prime number
- 13 Mean of 5 down and 12 up
- 14 All digits are the same

Down

- 1 Thirty-three times a square
- 2 6 down minus 11 across
- 5 Three times a prime number
- 6 A square
- 10 9 up minus 1 up
