
TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #55

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 8 up plus 4 across
- 4 Mean of 7 across and 8 down
- **6** 5 down minus 7 across
- 7 Mean of 3 up and 1 down

Up


- **3** Mean of 8 up and 3 down
- 5 Twice the result of 2 across minus 3 up 3 7 across divided by four
- **8** Mean of 3 down and 6 across
- **9** Mean of 1 down and 8 down

Down

- 1 Same as 5 up
- 5 2 across plus 8 down
- **8** Six times a square
