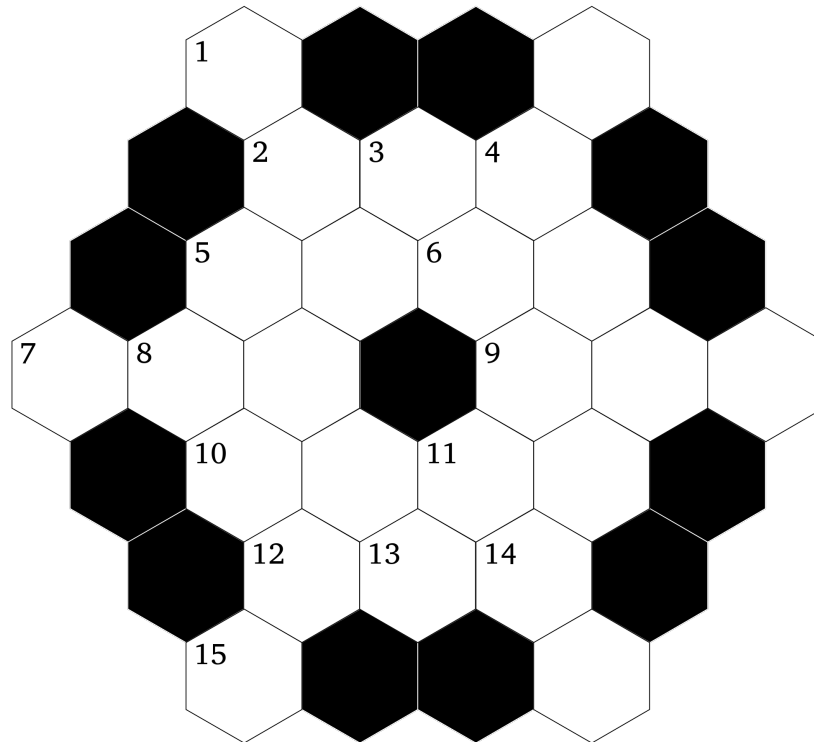


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #69

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 7 across plus half of 8 down
 5 Consecutive digits unordered
 7 A prime number
 9 Twice the result of 5 across minus 14
 10 Twice the result of 5 down minus 8 up
 12 A prime number

Up

- 6 Twice a prime number
 8 Fifty-six times a prime number
 10 A prime number
 13 Sixty-six times a prime number
 14 Five times a prime number
 15 A palindrome

Down

- 1 2 across minus 12 across
 4 13 up minus half of 6 up
 5 A prime number
 8 Eight more than 8 up
 11 Three-fourths of 1 down
