


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #1

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Mean of 8 across and 13 across
- **3** Twice the result of 2 down minus 10 across
- **4** 10 across times 1 across
- **8** 4 across divided by 1 across
- **10** 9 down divided by eight
- 11 Fifteen more than 4 across
- 13 3 down plus 7 down
- 14 11 across minus 6 down

Down

- **2** Twice a prime number
- **3** Fifty-one times 10 across
- **5** A palindrome
- **6** A prime number
- **7** All digits are the same
- **9** Eight times 8 across
- **11** Twice a prime number
- **12** Twice the result of 11 down plus 9 down
