
Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #7

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 18 across minus 14 down
- 4 15 down plus 16 down
- **6** Consecutive digits in descending order
- 7 Half of 1 down, then subtract 16 down
- **8** Twelve times a prime number
- 10 Half of 8 across, then subtract 15 down
- 11 Mean of 8 down and 16 across
- 12 Mean of 9 down and 13 down
- 14 Same as 1 down
- **16** A square
- 18 Mean of 6 across and 4 across
- 19 14 across minus 2 down

Down

- 1 Mean of 15 down and 16 across
- **2** 1 down minus 5 down
- 3 2 down plus 4 across
- 4 7 across plus 15 down
- 5 14 across minus 2 down
- **8** Twice a prime number
- **9** Fifty-two times 16 across
- **13** Four times a prime number
- **14** A square
- 15 19 across plus 14 down
- 16 17 down minus 1 down
- **17** A prime number
