
Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #9

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **3** Twice the result of 13 across plus 14 down
- 6 6 down minus 7 down
- **8** A prime number
- **9** A prime number
- 10 12 across minus 9 across
- 11 Forty-seven times a square
- **12** A prime number
- **13** Six times a prime number

Down

- **1** A prime number
- 2 Twice the result of 12 down minus 1 down
- **4** Three times a prime number
- 5 Mean of 4 down and 8 across
- **6** Thirteen times a prime number
- **7** Rearranged digits of 5 down
- **12** Three times a prime number
- **14** Six times a prime number
