


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #12

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 24 across minus 9 across
- 3 Twice the result of 17 down plus 16 across
- **6** 16 across minus 11 down
- 7 Mean of 13 down and 14 down
- 8 Half of 23 across, then subtract 5 down
- **9** A square
- **10** A square
- **11** A prime number
- **15** A square
- **16** 1 across minus 6 across
- 18 Mean of 21 across and 12 down
- 20 Mean of 1 down and 21 across
- 21 Twice 9 across
- 22 2 down minus 18 across
- 23 15 across minus 10 across
- **24** 4 down plus 12 down

Down

- 1 7 across plus 10 across
- **2** Mean of 4 down and 14 down
- 4 16 across plus 9 across
- **5** Four times 4 down
- 11 16 across minus 12 down
- **12** Four-fifths of 9 across
- 13 20 across minus 10 across
- 14 2 down minus half of 13 down
- 16 15 across minus half of 22 across
- **17** 21 across plus 4 down
- 18 5 down minus 16 across
- 19 Twenty-three times 13 down
