- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

8 Twenty-six times a prime number  
9 Seven times a prime number  
10 A prime number
