


# **Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #16**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### Across

- **1** Seven times 17 across
- 3 Forty-eight times 4 down
- **6** 14 down divided by 16 down
- 8 4 down reversed
- **9** 12 down minus half of 3 across
- 11 Twenty-four times a prime number
- **13** Rearranged digits of 5 down
- 15 Mean of 16 down and 4 down
- **17** A prime number
- **18** Twice the result of 1 across plus 13 across
- 19 1 down plus 2 down

#### Down

- **1** Thirty-four less than 13 across
- 2 17 down plus 4 down
- 4 Mean of 17 down and 17 across
- **5** Forty-one times 17 down
- **7** 17 across plus half of 11 across
- **9** Mean of 5 down and 16 down
- **10** Eight times a prime number
- 12 One hundred forty-seven more than 18 across
- 14 16 down times 15 across
- **16** A cube
- 17 Digits are the same as first two digits of 19 across
