
Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #19

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Twenty-two times a prime number
- **5** 1 down reversed
- 6 Mean of 13 across and 1 down
- **8** 1 down times 15 down
- **11** A prime number
- **12** 3 down divided by 16 across
- **13** A prime number
- 15 9 down minus 2 down
- **16** A prime number
- **18** Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 7 down

Down

- 1 4 down plus 12 across
- 2 10 down plus 7 down
- **3** Rearranged digits of 8 across
- **4** Sum of digits in 18 across
- **7** A prime number
- **9** Nineteen times a square
- **10** Twice the result of 13 down minus 11 across
- 13 2 down minus 7 down
- 14 13 across minus 17 down
- 15 Mean of 16 across and 17 down
- 17 Half of 15 across
