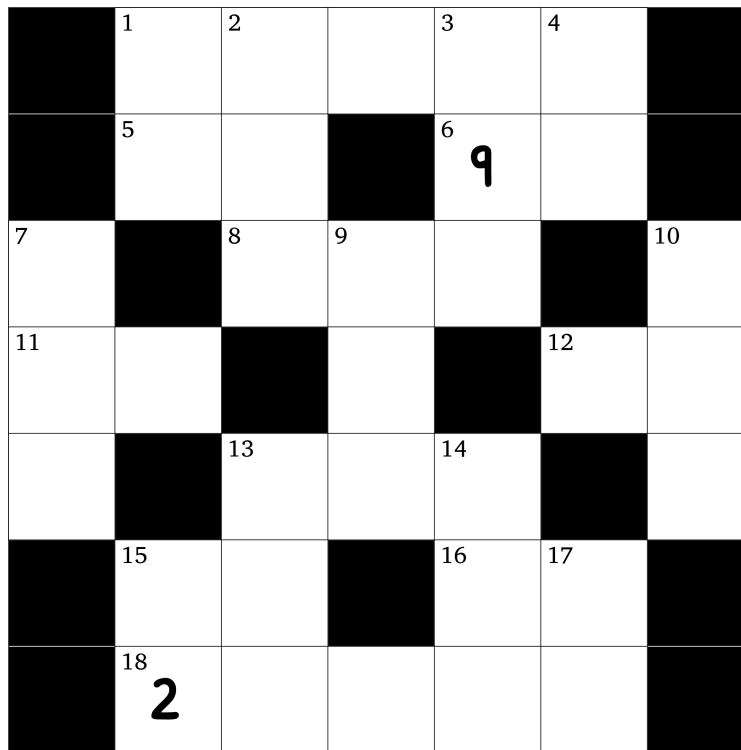


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #19

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Twenty-two times a prime number
- 1 down reversed
- Mean of 13 across and 1 down
- 1 down times 15 down
- A prime number
- 3 down divided by 16 across
- A prime number
- 9 down minus 2 down
- A prime number
- Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 7 down

Down

- 4 down plus 12 across
- 10 down plus 7 down
- Rearranged digits of 8 across
- Sum of digits in 18 across
- A prime number
- Nineteen times a square
- Twice the result of 13 down minus 11 across
- 2 down minus 7 down
- 13 across minus 17 down
- Mean of 16 across and 17 down
- Half of 15 across
