This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

## Across

- Rearranged digits of 2 down
- Mean of 2 down and 18 across
- A prime number
- Nineteen times a prime number
- Sum of digits in 6 down
- Twice a prime number
- 1 across times 8 down
- Three times a prime number
- Mean of 7 down and 1 down
- One hundred sixty more than 3 down

## Down

- Three times a prime number
- 5 across plus 17 across
- 15 across minus 10 across
- Four times a prime number
- 8 down plus 14 down
- Twice a prime number
- 1 across minus 17 across
- Six times a prime number
- Consecutive digits in descending order
- Half of 4 down, then subtract 14 down
