### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

### Across

- Twenty-three times 11 down
- Thirty-four times 4 down
- Same as 15 across
- A square
- Twice the result of 12 down plus 15 across
- Mean of 16 down and 18 across
- 4 down plus 19 down
- Three-fourths of 5 down
- Four-fifths of 6 across
- A square
- Half of 1 across, then subtract 2 down
- 19 down plus 9 across

### Down

- A square
- 10 across plus 15 across
- Mean of 7 down and 5 down
- Half of 18 across, then subtract 17 across
- A square
- 2 down minus 15 across
- Mean of 10 across and 7 across
- A square
- 17 across plus 19 down
- 17 across plus 10 across
- 2 down minus 18 down
- Twice the result of 6 across plus 15 down
- 21 across minus 13 across
- A square
